City ce The primary victim of the alleged poachings the endangered. Birminghamshire Pheasant. The three weeks have seen 13 alleged incidents of hunting of the pheasant, as well as the disco of four nests in the sanctuary believed to be intentionally destroyed.

Duncan, dressed as a Birminghamshire Phec egg in an effort to bring attention to these known 'crimes, fell from his perch on the wall or the crowded sidewalk below, possibly after losing balance in his costume. He sustained broken bon punctured lung, and critical damage to the cerebr cortex. Medical Emergency staff were on the immediately, but there was nothing that caul done for the fallen activist. Duncan was pronounce upon arrival at Birmingham General Hospital.
